Army Writing Style Guide BLUF: Bottom Line Up Front: Put the recommendation, conclusion or reason for writing -- the bottom line -- in the first or second paragraph, not at the end Use the active voice Concise, organized, to the point Use correct spelling, grammar, and punctuation Write in the first person using "I," "you" and "we" as subjects of sentences instead of "this office

Rules To meet Army writing standards, follow these composition rules from AR 25-50: Item Rule Bottom line up front State purpose and main point up front For example, put the recommendation, conclusion, or reason for writing in the first or second paragraph, not at the end Active voice Use active voice in most sentences Short words Choose one or two-syllable words over multi-syllable ones
